IMPAIRED DRIVER PROGRAM FEES

Please be aware that the Hope Council charges the following fees in the Impaired Driver Program:

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| Assessment for Kenosha County Residents..... | \$280.00 |
| Non-Compliance Fee (Applied when appointment is not made within 14 days of conviction or failed to complete Driver Safety Plan (DSP) within year's timeframe or comply with recommendations of the DSP)..... | \$50.00 |
| Alcohol and Other Drug Testing for those who have 3 or more lifetime offenses. This is a mandatory part of the DSP. You are charged the initial fee as a baseline test, and during the DSP, there will be no fewer than 2 additional tests, which will cost up to \$135 each..... | \$135.00 |
| Assessment for two (2) states (e.g., Kenosha County resident with a conviction in another state) | \$285.00 |
| Returned Check | \$40.00 |

RESCHEDULING AND CANCELLATION POLICY*

- There is no fee for cancellations made three (3) or more business days in advance of the appointment.
- There is a \$25 fee for cancellations made two (2) business days in advance of the appointment.
- There is a \$50 fee for cancellations made one (1) business day in advance of the appointment.
- There is a \$100 no-show fee for all appointment no-shows and cancellations the day of the appointment or cancellations made the day before the appointment but after the agency has closed.
- An appointment is considered cancelled if you are more than 15 minutes late or if you are present but will not be seen due to the determination made by Hope Council staff.
- All fees must be paid in full before an appointment can be rescheduled.

These fees do not include Driver Safety Plan costs or re-instatement fees with the Department of Motor Vehicles and are subject to change without notice.

POLICY ON ASSESSMENT APPOINTMENTS

It is the policy of the Hope Council to refuse assessment services to those appearing for their appointments under the influence of any mood-altering substance not used as prescribed. Should the assessor suspect that you are under the influence of ANY mood-altering substance, your appointment will be considered cancelled, and you will be required to reschedule.*

Your full attention is needed during the assessment, and ALL our clients deserve privacy. Therefore, NO ONE else, including children or infants, is allowed to wait in the lobby or be present during your assessment. Failure to adhere to this rule will require you to reschedule.*
